

'Sun Burst' Luxurious, Distinctive

In "Lamos Del Rey" (sun burst) by builder Joe Gilbreth, you can step into a world rich in luxurious appointments and tasteful decor. Constructed of white brick and accented with arched, grilled windows, the air conditioned home presents a picture of quality.

James Crow, AIA, is the architect of Lamos Del Rey and Emmons of Austin is the decorator.

A quarry tile foyer opens into the home's 22-foot, carpeted living room and dining area, or leads guests into the paneled family room with its vaulted ceiling and elevated brick fireplace.

Distinctiveness in this quality home is not limited to size and plain good livability, for each of the three bedrooms and two tile baths are exceptionally large.

The master bedroom has its own outside entrance that opens onto a walkway leading to a tree-shaded, elevated terrace and garden area. Too, the room has built-in desk, and 8x10 foot walk-in closet, a dressing area with vanity and full bath with tile vanity and linen storage.

The work-center, the kitchen, has a built-in cabinet top range, wall oven, dishwasher, disposal unit, pantry and post-topped cabinets. Adjoining is a breakfast room which holds promise of many hours of intimate family meals. The breakfast room, kitchen and family room all overlook the garden and terrace.

In addition, there's a large laundry room with exterior exit, and a separate door into the double garage. Its convenient storage and workshop area adds space for modern living in a beautiful home reminiscent of Spain.
