## Colonial Charm Adds To Allure of Heritage

The "Colonial Heritage" by West & Associates was designed by architect Thomas R. Campbell and decorated by Miss Margot Ford with furniture from the Carriage House.

Home builders Don West and Jim Fortune have maintained the warmth and charm of Colonial styling by effective use of antique brick, cedar shingles and a long veranda with six imposing white pillars.

Inside, a hand molded foyer opens to a 28-foot carpeted, formal living room and dining area. Elaborate, carefully hand-crafted cabinets punctuate the end of the entry foyer and divert traffic, left, to the bedroom wing or, right, to the home's furniture finished, ash paneled family room with red, antique brick fireplace and raised hearth. The broad fireplace wall holds a recessed tin-terbox and decorative ash finished mantle . . . a promise of fun-to-come during long winter months. Vaulted, exposed beam ceilings complete the picture of comfort.

The home's gay breakfast room, with bay-walls, shares the family room's view of the large, curved patio and garden area. Nearby, the kitchen has blending wood cabinets, formica cabinet tops, built-in Tappan range,

oven, dishwasher, disposal unit and pantry, and the utility room is just a door away.

Four bedrooms, two luxurious baths and fully carpeted dressing area add still more appeal to the fully carpeted, air conditioned home.
